

Field notes of part of E line of H + B + R Rk
Survey in Blk B. 2. Gray County Texas.

Begin at earth mound on South side of
creek $\frac{1}{4}$ mi S or from mail Station at forks of North
Fork of Red River near center of Gray County
from which earth mound is north or north + west
N 55 E 230 is and another north or north + west N 49 E
215 is for the N-E cor of Sec No 4 + S-E cor No 3 of
H + B + R Rk cert No ¹⁵/₃₁₅₁.

Variation 12° E determined by
calls for north or true north.

Hence S 1900 is stake and small pebble
stones on sand hills for S-E cor No 4 and N-E
cor No 5 Blk B. 2. H + B + R Rk Co.

Hence South 1432 is creek, a running stream at
1500 a stone mound on ridge at 1620 creek at
1900 is a stake on hill side for S-E cor No 5 +
N-E cor No 6 H + B + R Rk Co cert No ¹⁵/₃₁₅₂.

Hence South 1900 is a stake on msg flat
on South (side) slope of hill for S-E cor of No 6 +
N-E cor No 7 H + B + R Survey.

Hence South crossing Dry creek at 400 is
650 is, 1100 is, + 1700 is putting toward North Fork of
Red River, at 1900 is a stake on N slope for the
S-E cor No 7 + N-E cor No 8 H + B + R Rk cert No ¹⁵/₃₁₅₃.

Hence South 1600 is top of ridge between
North Fork breaks and Mclellan creek slope near
Jureno trail at 1900 is a stake on S slope for
S-E cor No 8 + N-E cor No 9 Blk B. 2. H + B + R Rk Survey.

Hence South along a creek on E bank, flows
to McClellan creek. 1900 is a stone on megr flat for
S E Cor No 9 + N E Cor No 10 Blk B. 2 H + L N R R.

Hence South at 320 is pass a stone and
on hilly bluff of Dry creek on S side of chow at
1900 is a stone on megr flat opposite mouth of
a dry ravine of creek from N 35 W 2 miles
for S E Cor 10 + N E Cor 11 + N W Cor 12 H + L N R R Survey.

Hence South 300 mouth of ravine west
side 700 is cross Dry creek along W side creek to
1900 is a stake in little McClellan creek valley
opposite upper end of bunch of timber and 3000
from it. S E Cor 11 + S W Cor 12 H + L N R R.

Hence South 3500 is a stone on N slope 3000 N of
top of hill, The divide between little + main McClellan
creeks - The N E Cor 13 + N W Cor 14 Blk B. 2. H + L N R R.

Hence South 600 is cross a chow to main
McClellan creek eastward 1500 is, draw toward
Vails Camp, at 1900 is a stone on N slope of
ridge for S E Cor 11 + S W 12 + N E Cor 15
Blk B. 2. H + L N R R Cor 15 $\frac{15}{3156}$ + $\frac{15}{3157}$.

Hence South 1500 is cross ravine to
Vails Camp on McClellan creek, 1900 is a stone and on
hills in roughest breaks in neighborhood about
 $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from McClellan creek + $\frac{3}{4}$ m from creek S E.
This Cor is on high hill for S E Cor Survey No 15
H + L N R R Blk B. 2.
