
The Geo Sides survey I think joins 1900 vs further west and in part conflicts with 63 & 64 C6, which surveys I am called upon to correct. The pulling apart of the Hecht Blk 20 & C6, would make conflict of the Geo Sides and May 11th 1879 surveys with 63, 64, 86 & 87 of Blk C6 and 13 A. I desire to correct all of these. I am the owner of Sec 13 A in name of C Sadnight. I note that the field notes made by McClelland on this survey Jan 1 1883 would make but slight conflict with Geo Sides survey but the field notes of Patent on same make larger conflict. I desire it ~~to~~ corrected and Patent.
