

Donley County, Clarendon, August 23<sup>rd</sup> 1888.

Hon. R. M. Hall, Com. Gen. Land Office, Austin.

In reply to your favor of Aug. 20 I herewith hand you the field notes taken by me in April and May 1888.

Begin at an iron pipe the S.E. cor. 75 Block B2 as set by <sup>P.G. Omohundro,</sup> ~~Jeraud~~  
 Thence North 492 varas to a pipe the S.W. cor. 46 Block B2 <sup>Var. 10.50 E.</sup>  
 Thence East 1915 varas a pipe for the S.E. cor. 46 B2.  
 Thence East 1910 varas a pipe. Thence East 1913 varas a pipe.  
 Thence East 1911 varas, a pipe. Thence NO' 40' W 1916 varas a pipe the  
 S.W. cor. 14 B2, as set by Mr. <sup>Omohundro</sup> ~~Jeraud~~. Thence East 1900 varas, a pipe st  
 for S.E. cor 14 B2. and the N.E. cor Rockwell Co School Land.  
 Thence South 157 varas a point 69 varas due West of the N.W. cor. of  
 the J. W. McLaren pre-emption, at 708 varas a point 49 varas West of  
 the S.W. cor. sur. 1 made for the G.C. & S. F. R. R. Co. (April 25 1888.)

Begin at the N.E. cor. 16 <sup>REH</sup> made for A.W. Wallace West 5821 varas a  
 mound the N.W. cor. 15 for A. W. Wallace. Thence West 5787 varas to  
 a point. Thence North 35 varas to the pipe, cor of 7 & 8 B2. Var. 10. <sup>1/2 E</sup>

May 1st 1888. Begin at the iron pipe set by Jeraud for the N.W.  
 cor. 20 in Block 30. Thence South at 1107 varas a point 237 varas E.  
 of a point set by J. O. B. Street for the N.E. cor. of survey No. 2

in Block 2, believed to an error. at 1300 varas a mound, for S.W. 20.  
 Thence West at 1005 varas a stake on bank of McClellan creek whence  
 a cottonwood marked A the witness to the N.E. cor of survey No. 1 for  
 G.C. & S.F.R.R. Co. bears 321' 0" W. 135 varas. at 1900 varas a mound in  
 of McClellan creek. Thence South 500 varas set a rock mound for the  
 S.E. cor. 4 in Block 2. Thence West at 1400 varas a mound the N.E. ~~cor~~  
 cor. of sur. 7 Block 2. at 1900 varas set a skillet in earth mound for  
 S.W. cor. 4 Block 2. Thence West at 1030 varas cross the N. Fork of  
 McClellan creek, at 1400 varas a mound for the N.W. cor. 7 Block 2,  
 at 1900 varas set a stake in earth m'd and 4 pits for the S.W. cor. 5  
 Block 2. whence the N.E. cor. of the J.J. Burdick pre-emption bears No. <sup>th</sup>  
 381 varas and West 124 varas. Thence South at 1452 varas cross  
 McClellan creek, at 1400 varas set a rock in m'd for the S.E. cor. 10  
 for B.B. Thence West at 348 varas cross McClellan creek, at 1900  
 varas set a m'd for the S.W. cor. 10, B.B. Thence North at 345 vs  
 a point. Thence West at 973 varas a point. Thence West at 1900 vara  
 an iron pipe set by Omohundro for the N.E. cor. 13 Block B2. Thence  
 South 1910 varas to the N.E. cor. 15 Block B2.

May 9th 1888. Var. 10.52' E. Begin at the S.E. cor. of survey No  
 75, as set by P. G. Omohundro, an iron pipe in earth mound.  
 Thence South 1900 varas set a rock mound. Thence South 1900 varas  
 set a large flat rock in rock mound in flat 10 varas below hill, <sup>whence</sup>  
 Hassars house bears N. 11 E. 100 varas. Thence South at 312 varas cross  
 McClellan creek, at 1900 varas a rock mound in head of a cañon. S.E. 15  
 Thence South 1900 varas set a rock for S.E. 16 C2. Thence South at 330  
 varas cross head of Houston cañon, at 1900 set 2 rocks on plains for  
 S.E. 25 C2. Thence West 1900 varas a stake for S.W. cor. 25 C2  
 Thence West 1900 varas set a rock for the N.W. 27 C2. Thence West  
 1900 varas set a rock for the N.W. cor. 30, C2. Thence West 1900 varas  
 set 3 rocks in m'd for N.W. cor. 33 C2. Thence West 1900 varas set a  
 rock for N.W. cor. 32 C2. whence the cor set by McClelland for N.E. cor  
 survey 3 in Block B3 bears 317.37' W. 145 varas, and another cor. brs  
 356.45' W. and is 311 varas south of the first.

May 10th, 1888. Var. 10.52' E. Begin at the new N.E. corner  
 27 C2 as set above, Thence South ~~at~~ at 1700 varas cross a cañon at  
 1900 varas, a rock in m'd for S.E. cor. 27 C2. Thence South at 126  
 varas cross a cañon at 325 varas cross a bluff at 1900 varas a point  
 in a cañon, placed a rock m'd 72 varas South of it. for S.W. cor. 23 C2.  
 Thence South, 1900 varas a rock mound. Thence South, 1900 varas a
