Dear Sir;

Your letter of Oct. 2 to Hamilton & Deaver, this city, has been handed me for attention. Re. Gray County Lands.

I have surveyed this 25 section pasture to determine how to prepare field notes as you requested. This block No. 25, H. & G. N. was surveyed by Storrs in 1888. According to his field notes iron pipes were placed as indicated on the accompanying map by "0". During 58 years of Panhandle wind rain and oil field traffic the pipes have nearly all been lost. Mr. Dial the owner told me, before beginning, that only one pipe was to be found, however I found three. My notes show my idea of disposal of excess. Perhaps you will prefer to use the Storr notes.

Is it asking for a variation of your custom that you examine these notes ^{before} having them recorded in the Gray County surveyors records?
