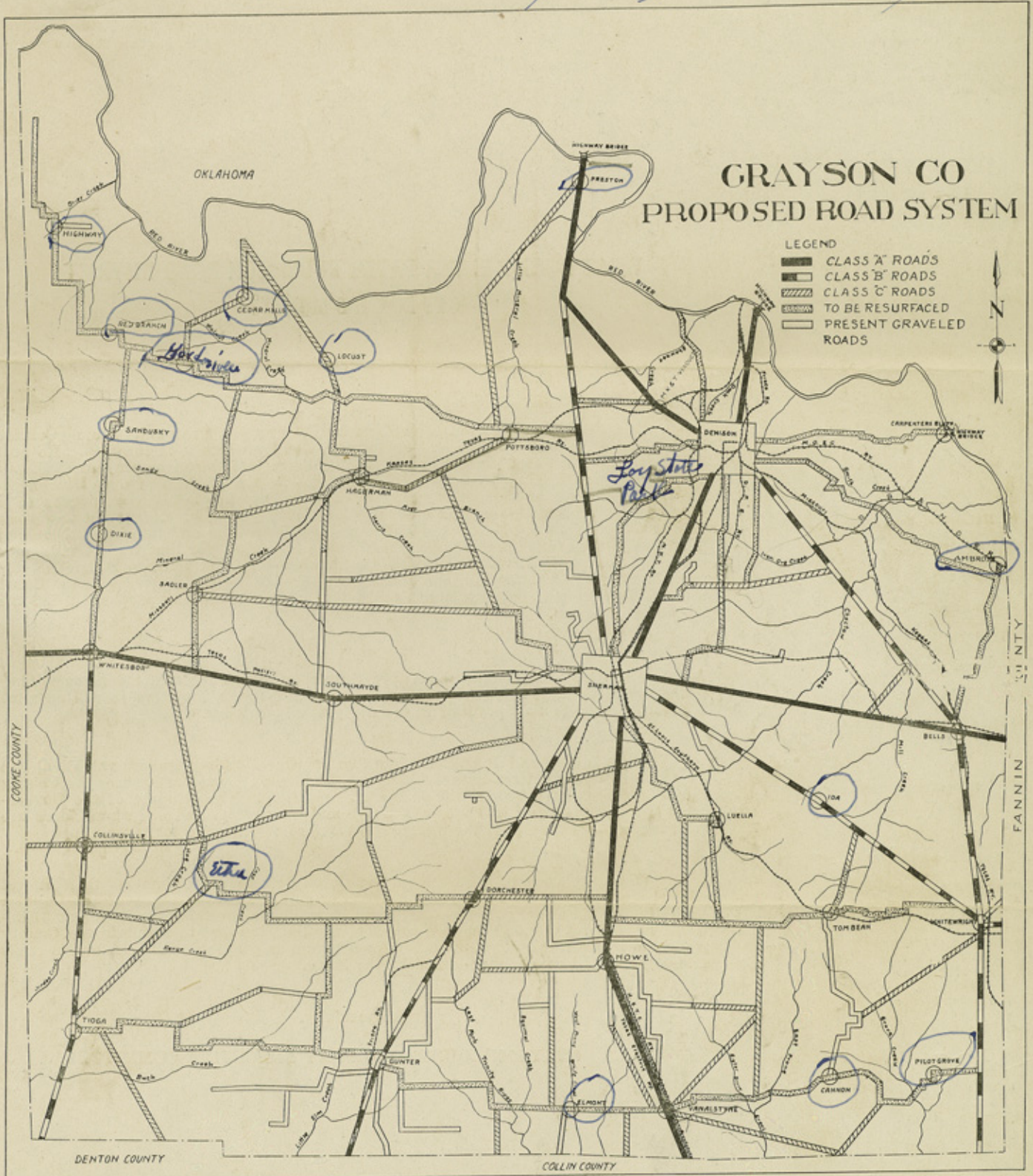


Class A roads are concrete or its equivalent; Class B roads are black top, asphalt roads; Class C new roads are gravel roads to cost about \$7,000 per mile. Class C present gravel roads to be resurfaced, straightened and new and wider bridges to cost about \$5,000 per mile.

According to the election order, money will be spent on 11 roads leading into Denison and on 10 roads leading into Sherman. SEE MAP:



The names of Gordonville and Ethel were inadvertently omitted from the map.

Will the tax payers of Grayson County continue to send their money to Austin to help build roads in other counties or will they vote for the bond issue and receive about \$1,000,000 Federal and State aid to help build roads in Grayson County? A vote for the bond issue means a vote for progress.
