
Class roads are concrete or its equivalent; Class B roads are black top, asphalt roads; Class C new roads are gravel roads to cost about \$7,000 per mile. Class C present gravel roads to be resurfaced, straightened and new and wider bridges to cost about \$5,000 per mile.

According to the election order, money will be spent on 11 roads leading into Denison and on 10 roads leading into Sherman. SEE MAP:
