Survey of six hundred and forty acres of land made for Daniel Moseley by virtue of Certificate No.75, Issued by the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Harrison for six hundred and forty acres of land, situated about 1 mile North of the Sabine River and about one mile West of Jonesborough road. Survey No.250. Beginning at the N. W. corner of No.249 from which a pine 12 inches D. bears N. $79\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 5-2/10 vrs., a Pine 12 inches D. bears S. $13\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., dist. 3 vrs; Thence West 367 vs. Branch 1 V.C. S.W. 1052 vs. Branch 1 vr.C. South, 1900-8/10 vrs. set stake in edge of flag pond from which a pine 36 inches D. bears N. 83° E., dist. 50 vrs., an overcup 24 inches D. bears S. 72° E., dist. 45-4/10 vs. Thence South 1900-8/10 vrs. set stake on the head of lake, from which a willow Oak 10 inches D. bears S. 27° W., dist.3 vrs., a Willow Oak 12 inches D. bears S. $66\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., dist. 9 vrs.

Thence East 1900-8/10 vrs., S. W. Corner of No. 249 vrs. from which a pine 12 inches D. bears S 22° E., dist. 17-6/10 vs. a Pine 8 inches D. bears S. $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., dist. 5 vrs.

Thence North with the line of No.249, 1900-8/10 vrs. place of beginning. 640 acres of land. Oak, hickory and pine timber. Surveyed 26th. day of January 1846.
