

Navasota Grimes County Texas July 14th 1873

Hon^l Jacob Kuehler

Sir

In regard to the J. G. Wood
One Emption 160, Acre Survey in this County - you
state that it conflicts with the Gordon McGuffin
Patented Survey - there is not only no conflict on
the ground with the two named surveys but
there is nearly a space of 400 varas existing between
said Woods West boundary and McGuffins East line
which I will fully explain - there is on the books
of my office the Records of two different Surveys
made by virtue of Certificate N^o 96 issued by the Board
of Land Commissioners of Montgomery County to G. McGuffin
- the first Survey is Recorded on Page 81. first Class
Records of my office - and is for 369 Acres and begins
800 varas North 89° East from J H Parsons North East
corner and Surveyed by A Mc Neil Sept^r Surveyor on
the 22nd June 1838 - the other Field Notes of said McGuffin's
Survey is on Page 218 same Book and is for 2 1/3^d Labors
or 413 acres and begins 350 varas N 89° E. from J H Parsons
counter 21637

North East corner and was made by A McNeil on the
24th January 1840 this last Survey it seems is the one
on which said McGuffins Patent was issued

When I made J G Woods Pre Emption Survey I had
found the Recorded field Notes of McGuffins first
Survey and took a copy of them not knowing of
or suspecting the existence of two field Notes for
the same land- therefore in making said Woods Survey
I began at the North West corner of B B B & C R R Co 160,
acre survey and Run West 460 varas to the North East
corner of said McGuffins first survey which corner I
found at that distance and identified by said field Notes
I then Run South with said McGuffins East line which
line I found plainly marked also finding the Creek at the
proper distance as represented in said field Notes
I made and sent to your office field Notes of Woods Pre Em.
calling for said McGuffins North East corner and East line
but some twelve months after making said Woods
Survey I discovered the field Notes of McGuffins second
Survey which began only 350 varas N 89° E from Persons
North East corner- I then went on the ground and found
McGuffins East boundary proper- truly leaving really
a space of 450 varas between Woods West boundary and
said McGuffins East line proper- I also found the
counter 24638

McGuffin. J. G. Woods 133 1/3 & C.R.R. Co survey and the
 450 vara strip or vacancy between Woods and McGuffin
 all fits up exactly as I find it on the ground and by
 placing the J.H. Pearson Survey 503 varas West from
^{North} Fatty Gibbons North East corner also reconciles the
 apparent discrepancy in the surveys West of said
 Persons and ^{South of} Fatty Gibbons - East of Sandy H. Walker
 and South of Nancy Anderson and Ken Brunner's
 Surveys - all of which I explained and showed in the
 sketch of Map sent to your office in November 1872
 and since verified by affidavit sent to your office

P.S. the only error in J. G. Woods Prop. 160 acre survey is the call at its
 NW corner and West boundary for McGuffins N.E. corner and East boundary -
 as to reducing the distance of Woods North boundary and then claiming
 it to join to McGuffins East boundary is utterly impossible for me to do
 as there is yet really left a space of 450 varas between the two surveys

discrepancy existing on the ground with the J. H. Person ^{Survey},
and the Wm. Fitz Gibbons League and made and sent to
your office a sketch showing the discrepancies -

I see in a late Map from your office of Grimes County
that there is a space left between J. G. Woods Rail-^co Survey
and the West boundary of 13 B. B. & C. R. R. Co., 160 Acre Survey
that is incorrect as my field Notes of said Woods Survey
begins at the North West corner of said Rail road survey
and makes an L around the South 8 sides of it

Now the J. H. Person 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Labor Survey gives no definite
beginning point but on all of the Maps of this County its
South East corner is represented as cornering ^{willy} ~~next~~ North
East corner of the Fitz Gibbons League when in fact it is
503 varas West from said Fitz Gibbons N.E. corner
G. McGuffins first survey began N 89° E. 800 varas
from J. H. Person's North East corner and his second Survey
begins 350 varas from said Person's N.E. corner.

Gwyn Morrisons 3 $\frac{1}{3}$ " Labor Survey begins 1100 varas
North 89° East from McGuffins Survey, North East corner,
I am satisfied that G. Morrisons Survey was begun
1100 varas N 89° E from the North East corner of McGuffins
first Survey by ^{admitting} that to be the case and also placing the
J. H. Person Survey 503 varas West from Fitz Gibbons North
East corner as it actually is then the Person Survey the
