Dear Sir

I respectfully call your attention to the accompanying sketch relating to surveys on the Waters of Cottonwood creek in this County, made by virtue of Certificate No. 37 issued to John Mills for 600 acres, and said Cert. No. 68 for 600 acres issued to the San Antonio & Mexican Gulf R.R. Co.

The sketch shows data obtained by careful measurements of all the surrounding surveys. I am satisfied that vacancies exist between the Fulcher & Mitchell, and between the Campbell, and Cowan & Keller, and also at other points indicated on the sketch. If the Commissioner does not consider the objections to existing patents on the above surveys as insuperable, I would like to present a written statement, or have a personal interview to lay before him the proofs that I have, that such vacancies do actually exist. Before patents are again <sup>issued</sup> ~~acted for~~ some changes will have to be made in the field notes on file to accommodate them to data obtained from recent investigations & re-measurements, which are represented on the accompanying plat
