Enclosed find a plat showing the relative position and location of the J. O. Blair, D. Chandler and L. T. Tucker surveys, adjoining the J. D. Thompson survey, all in Guadalupe County (northwestern portion thereof near the Guadalupe River). You will notice that according to the field notes of these surveys there is a wedge shaped piece of property which shows by the county map to be in the Tucker survey when same is excluded by its field notes, leaving same apparently unpatented, not included in the field notes of surrounding property owners, and no legal title thereto emanating from the sovereignty. I would be glad if you would let me know the exact status of this matter, and what is necessary to secure title to same.

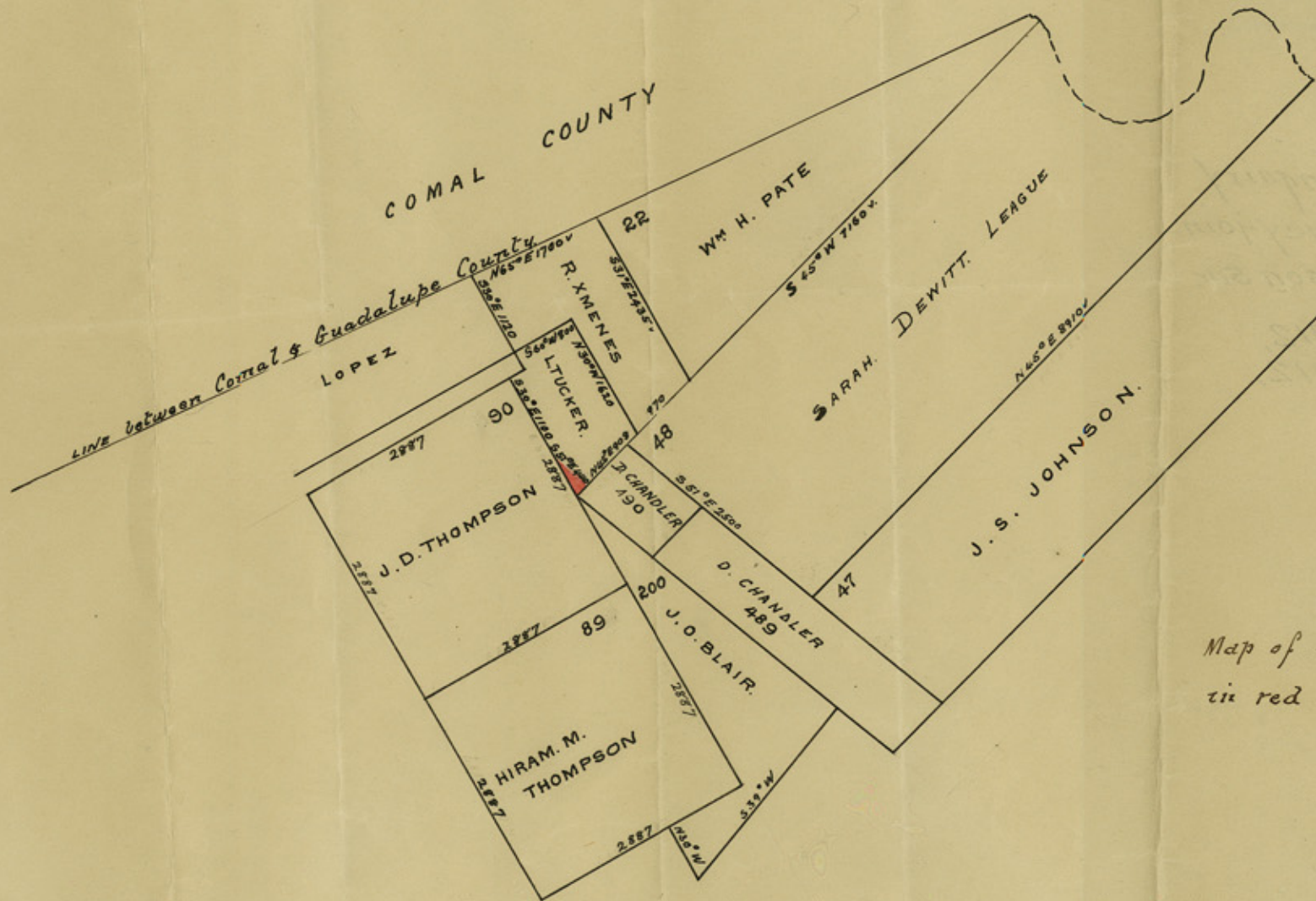
