Dear Sir:-

Answering your letter of 16th. inst., in reference to a conflict or shortage in Block 2, Public School land in Hansford County, I beg to advise that said Block 2 is junior to adjoining blocks, both on the east and west, hence if there is an actual conflict or shortage in the distance E. and W. between said blocks the surveys in Block 2 should be corrected so as to conform to said adjacent block lines. The east line of Block "D", H. & G.N. Ry. Co. on the west should be established 11 miles east of the original N.E. corner of Survey #135 on Rabbit Bar Creek in Block No. 2, G.H. & H. Ry. Co. and the West line of Block No. 2, S.A. & M.G. Ry. Co., on the east of Block No. 2, Public School, should be located from corners of surveys in Block No. 45, T.C. Ry. Co. as established from the original S.E. corner of Survey No. 49, or from re-survey corners in said Block 45 by J.L. Long in 1888.

While all the surveys in these several blocks call to run N., S., E. and W. their actual course must be determined from actual findings on the ground in the different blocks.

If you have occasion to furnish corrected field notes for any surveys in said Block 2, Public School kindly accompany same with a sketch and full report showing how you identified and established the adjoining blocks on the ground.
