Jack Land District I John W Hale a Deputy  
Surveyor of Jack Land District.

do hereby certify that the description and fieldnotes  
as given in the corrected connecting line  
of the William Richardson 640 acre Survey in  
Harrison County as herein described is an section  
97 covering the fork of the Big Wichita River  
and not an section 81 as called for at the  
Beginning of said Connecting line. Section  
81 is about 35 miles further up the Big  
Wichita than 97 the fork at which the connecting  
line of Said Richardson 640 acre Survey was  
begun. The corner as described in the fork of  
said Big Wichita on Section 97 is correctly  
described as the Beginning of said connecting  
line. The proper and correct connection from  
said corner in said fork an section 97 and  
said corner is hereby correctly described  
and should read as follows. Beginning at said  
forks of Big Wichita River an section 97  
of Block \_\_\_\_\_ of what is known as Sect. 97  
of the H & S. R. R. Co. a Stake in the forks of  
said Big Wichita River from which two  
bunches of Hackberry's marked with lines =  
one of which lrs. S 57° W 5 m. the lrs N 61° E  
5 m. Thence North 15200 vars a Stake  
Thence West 9500 vars a Stake in the Valley  
of Deer Creek a tributary of Beaver Creek  
which is tributary of Big Wichita River  
from which two Hackberry's each 4 inches  
diameter are marked X the other Blazes  
and Hacks lrs. S 20° W 374 1/2 m. counter 2985

a wild Chiarkee Standing on the Bank of  
Deer Creek 8 inches in Diameter marked H.  
bss N 45° W 43 3/4 rs. a double Chittum tree  
8 inches in dia. Standing on the Bank of Deer  
Creek are marked to the other marked X  
bss N 32° W 30 9/16 rs. a double Hackberry  
Standing on the Bank of Deer Creek 5 inches  
in dia. marked Blazes and Hocks bss N 31 1/2°  
E. 205 rs. Thence North 11400 rs. to the  
S E and the Beginning corner of said  
William Richards or Survey a Stake from  
which a Hackberry 12 inches in dia. bss N 40°  
W 133 rs. marked X Thence North at 840 rs.  
Hab Creek a tributary of Beaver Creek at  
1900 rs. a Stake from which a mesquite tree  
marked X bss N 40° W 36 rs. Thence West  
1900 rs. to a Stake for corner on the E. B. line  
of the abb Survey Jr. League & Labor Survey  
Thence South with the E line of said Survey  
Jr. Survey Crossing Hab Creek 1900 rs.  
to a Stake for corner. Thence East 1900 rs. to  
the place of Beginning. Resurveyed and corrected  
Corrected October 12<sup>th</sup> 1879.
