Beginning at a stake on the West bank of Standers  
 Creek the S.E. cor of Survey No 11 Block 10  
 At + C. R.R. Co from which a Cotta tree was 34 1/2  
 W - 9 vs a Gum Elastic S 49 1/2 E - 12 vs. Thence North  
 433 vs to a Cotta tree standing in good state  
 of preservation, 190 vs south from S. B. of Red river  
 now br. taken as follows. Cotta tree S 40 1/2 E - 248 vs  
 a br. S 78 E - 314 1/2 vs. <sup>Thence S 73 W 1370 vs.</sup> Thence West 7 miles + 127 vs  
 to N.W. cor of No 13 Block "H", At + N.W. R.R. Co.  
 Thence South 9 miles + 314 vs to a point 700 vs  
 East + 161 vs North from Standers Cr. the common  
 corner of Sur<sup>s</sup> No<sup>s</sup> 40, 41, 42 + 57. Thence East 4961 vs  
 to Standers Cr. Thence North 957 vs. Thence  
 East 778 vs to a point in S. L of Sec. No 5-3 Block 10  
 from which a Pecan tree S 64 W 11 vs. br S 29 W - 15 vs  
 both plainly marked + in good state preservation  
 begin again at N.W. cor. of Sec 13 Block "H",  
 Thence South 1735 vs to its S.W. cor. Thence  
 West at 2 miles + 500 vs cross Barrs Cr. at  
 3 miles + 32 vs the center of Groves Creek.  
 at 3 miles + 127 vs the sand hills. at 4 miles  
 measured North 1210<sup>00</sup> to South bank of Red  
 river, at 4853 vs near sand hills. at 8 miles  
 + 709 vs the N.W. cor of Sur No 122 Block "H" from which

a Pond on North 10 vs a clump of bushes on Sand Hill on N 5 E. Thru West 1 mile + 54 vs to stake in ravine from which 2 China trees both marked brs S 24 E - 77 vs. Thru West 13 vs on cross Knobuck Cr. at 2 miles a pile of rock from which 2 Hackbys? brs S 61 E - 15 1/2 vs a pile of rock being 450 on South Knobuck Cr. Thru West 400 Knobuck Cr. 1900 vs a over 2<sup>nd</sup> md. Thru North at 1 mile + 390 vs cross Linnies Cr. at 4 miles the N. E. cor of Sur No 201 Blk St. Thru West 2 miles. Thru North 1 mile + 1665 vs cross branch at 2 miles the N. E. cor of 230. Thru West at 3 miles + 400 vs cross Cr. at 9 miles + 432 vs the N. W. cor of Sur No 305 - from which a China 15 in dia brs N 6 W 50 vs. Thru West 21 miles + 1090 vs a stake & ground. Thru North 7027 vs to N. W. cor of No 783 Blk St. From which a China stump 12 in dia brs N 24 E - 55 vs a do 6 in dia brs N 9 W 20 vs both in ravine. The trunk of the last mentioned bearing was found lying beside the stump plainly marked thus X, and is 15-20 vs west of Baylor Cr & about 90 vs south of Red river. New bearings taken as follows:  
 To wit: China mtd X N 23 E - 60 vs a do mtd V brs N 41 E - 52 vs. Thru West 3104 vs cross Cr. at 3940 vs cross Thornton Cr. at 5700 vs the N. W. cor of Sur 788. Thru Contin West 180 vs a point in N. L of Sur 793. Thru North 1620 vs Mountain Cr. at 2790 vs a point in prairie. Thru East 1350 vs to a Cedar stake

marked on one side B + B + on the other  
T. W. R. said stake being the S. E. cor of Brooks  
& Burleson Survey in the St. Line of Survey  
No 43 made for Stovall. 1010 vs South of  
outh of Mountain Cr. Beginning again  
at N. W. cor No 788. Thence West 2 miles. Thence  
North 2 miles to the N. W. cor of Sur. 796. 61K 1/2  
a md + 4 pits about 1000 vs South of Pease river  
fr. wh. the North end of a flat top Mt. brs S 75 W  
the South end of the said Mt. brs S 70 W.

Beginning again at the N. W. cor of Sur No 783  
Thence South 3160 vs bed of North Pease river.  
at 45203 vs cross branch at 45933 vs another br  
at 46683 a rock md the S W cor of Sur 756.  
Thence East 250 the bluffs of South Pease river  
Surveyed March 31<sup>st</sup> to April 9<sup>th</sup> 1884  
All the old brs called for were marked X  
Variation  $9^{\circ} 45' E.$
