

FIELD NOTES OF A CONNECTING LINE SURVEY RUN FROM THE NW CORNER SECTION 2, BLOCK "H", W&NW RR CO SURVEY AND THE SOUTHERNMOST SW CORNER OF SECTION 2, GC&SF RR CO SURVEY, CERT. 4/840, AN IRON PIN IN A FENCE CORNER 50 VS N 2°E OF AN IRON PIN SET FOR THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 6, BLOCK "H", TO THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 9 AND THE NE CORNER SECTION 10, BLOCK "H" IN THE SBL OF SECTION 15, C&M RR CO SURVEY.

BEGINNING AT THE SAID NW CORNER SECTION 2, BLOCK "H", W&NW;

THENCE N 2°E ALONG THE WBL SECTION 2, GC&SF AND THE EBL SECTION 6, BLOCK "H", AT 1245 VS PASS HOUSE PLACE ON THE WEST, AND AT 1900 VS AN INTERIOR ELL CORNER OF SECTION 2, GC&SF AND THE NE CORNER SECTION 6, BLOCK "H", AN OLD BOIS D ARC POST AT AN OLD, LONG ESTABLISHED AND RECOGNIZED FENCE CORNER;

THENCE N 88°W ALONG THE NBL BLOCK "H" A FENCE ON THE NBL SECTION 6 AND THE SBL SECTION 2, GC&SF,

AT 143 VS CROSS SPRING BRANCH CALLED FOR IN ORIGINAL FIELD NOTES OF SECTION 6 AND AT 1356 VS CROSS A DEEP DRAW CALLED FOR IN SAME FIELD NOTES,

AT 1670 VS PASS THE SW CORNER SECTION 2, GC&SF AND SE CORNER SECTION 1, SAME SURVEY AND CERT., AN OLD FENCE LINE COURSE N 2°E AND THE OWNERSHIP BOUNDARY RECOGNIZED BY THE OWNERS OF RECORD,

AT 1918 VS PASS THE NW CORNER SECTION 6, BLOCK "H" AND NE CORNER SECTION 7, BLOCK "H", A FENCE CORNER AND OWNERSHIP BOUNDARY.

AT 2444 VS CROSS A DEEP DRAW CALLED FOR IN FIELD NOTES OF SECTION 7,

AT 2814 VS PASS FENCE, EBL HAYHURST EST., COURSE N 2°E,

AT 2884.6 VS PASS FENCE ON EAST SIDE OF COUNTY ROAD THAT TURNS WEST AT THIS POINT, AND FOLLOWING THE COUNTY ROAD,

AT 2892.5 VS PASS THE CENTERLINE OF THE N-S COUNTY ROAD,

AT 3004.4 VS PASS THE SW CORNER SECTION 1, GC&SF, CERT. 4/840 AND THE SE CORNER SECTION 2, TYLER TAP RR CO SURVEY, NO EVIDENCE OF ANY CORNER FOUND,

AT 3821.7 VS PASS THE NW CORNER SECTION 7 AND THE NE CORNER SECTION 8, BLOCK "H", NO EVIDENCE OF ANY CORNER FOUND BUT THERE IS AN OLD FENCE COURSE S 2°W FROM THIS POINT,

AT 4146.4 VS PASS THE SW CORNER SECTION 2 AND THE SE CORNER SECTION 1, TYLER TAP RR CO SURVEY, NO EVIDENCE FOUND OF ANY CORNER,

AT 5215.9 VS PASS CULVERT IN DRAW,

AT 5565.4 VS PASS THE SW CORNER SECTION 1, TYLER TAP AND SE CORNER SECTION 1, GC&SF RR CO SURVEY, CERT. 5058, NO EVIDENCE FOUND OF ANY CORNER,

AT 5739.7 VS PASS THE NW CORNER SECTION 8 AND NE CORNER SECTION 9, BLOCK "H", NO EVIDENCE OF ANY CORNER FOUND,

AT 6213.9 VS PASS THE SW CORNER SECTION 1, GC&SF AND THE SE CORNER SECTION 16, C&M RR CO SURVEY, NO EVIDENCE OF ANY CORNER FOUND IN THE ROAD BUT THERE IS AN OLD FENCE, THE PROPERTY LINE BETWEEN HAYHURST EST. AND J.B.MULKEY OWNERS OF RECORD OF SEC. 1 AND SEC. 16. THE FENCE RUNS N 0°15'E FROM THIS POINT TO THE RED RIVER,

AT 6698.7 VS PASS THE NW CORNER NE 1/4 AND NE CORNER NW 1/4 SECTION 9, BLOCK "H", NO EVIDENCE OF CORNER BUT THERE IS A PROPERTY BOUNDARY LINE COURSE S 2°W FROM THIS POINT,

AT 7279.9 VS PASS THE SW CORNER SECTION 16, C&M RR CO SURVEY AND THE SE CORNER SEC. 15, SAME SURVEY, NO EVIDENCE OF ANY CORNER IN THE ROAD, BUT FROM THIS POINT A LINE N 0°15'E FOLLOWS THE EAST SIDE OF AN OLD ROAD TO A RED RIVER CROSSING,

AT 7657.7 VS THE NW CORNER SEC. 9 AND NE CORNER SEC. 10, BLOCK "H", IN THE COUNTY ROAD INTERSECTION, NO EVIDENCE OF ANY CORNER FOUND BUT THIS N-S ROAD IS RECOGNIZED AS THE WBL SEC. 9 AND IS THE PROPERTY LINE BOUNDARY BETWEEN THE OWNERS OF RECORD.

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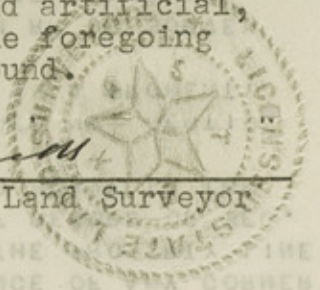
