the accompanying sketch is a correct sketch of
the surveys taken from the County maps of
Hardin County, the only maps now in use in
this office made by A. S. B. Tompkins for
the County Court of Hardin County in the year
1858 or 9 when I was County Surveyor of said
County and upon which W. A. Allen Deputy
County Surveyor under William Wood County
Surveyor of said County plotted the Maria
Ximenes League of land as represented on said map
and accompanying sketch thereof

I further certify that the Preemption survey of one
hundred and sixty acres of land made for John H
Cotton and the Survey of Three hundred and twenty
acres of land made by virtue of a certificate for C. H.
S. Ford and the Forty acre survey made by virtue
of B. B. B. & C. B. B. Co certificate do not conflict with
the Maria Ximenes League of land nor any
other survey as represented on said map.

I further certify that I went upon the ground where
the Maria Ximenes League of land is represented
to be located on a sketch obtained from the General
Land Office said State by Major Van Houten with
said sketch together with a certified copy of the
field notes of the Maria Ximenes league, and
commenced at the S. W. corner of the J. B. Reeves
Survey of 640 acres and run S. 1040 varas Thence
1220 var Thence N. 400 var at which point and
in the vicinity thereof I examined minutely and
confusedly for the N. E. corner of the said Ximenes

League and could find no traces whatever of the corners
or bearing trees nor the East or North boundary line
of said League, I then commenced at that point and
run a line N. 30° 30' W. the distance as shown by said
certified copy of said field notes from the N. E. corner
of the said Xenemes League, at which point I
examined and found no stream of water or
creek whatever neither in the vicinity thereof,
as it is represented in the said copy of the said
field notes of the said Xenemes League represent-
ing that the N. B. line of said League crosses a creek
5 Varas wide Course N. E. a tributary of Big Alabama
had I continued this line the distance required to
reach the supposed N. W. corner of said League
and found any stream of water it would flow from
the nature of the ground run into Little Bear
Island Bogus as no stream from the face of
country could possibly empty into Big Alabama
Creek

I further certify that the locality of said Xenemes
League as represented on said sketch from the General
land office is in what is called the Big Thicket and
by no possible means could any corner of said Xen-
emes League commence in a Prairie 1156 Varas
thence to Timber in the shape of said League.

So as to embrace or cover the said 160, 320, and 40
acre surveys as represented on said county maps and run
3000000 the N. W. corner thence N. 40° 00' W. to a creek's mouth emptying in Big Alabama
I further certify that the survey of three hundred
and twenty acres made by virtue of B. B. B. & C. & Co
certificate does not conflict with the J. B. Beaus
survey but commences on the E. B. line of the same
