I send you a plot of the above surveys that are situated on Pine Hand Bayou Hardin County, with correct connection line - Enclosure you will find a plot & connection line of Willis Donahoe Tittle & Lefran Gedy Tittle, and F. S. Green Tittle, and A. M. Lagarza Tittle. I found the corners called for in the field notes of the above named survey and made careful connection by actual survey upon the ground. The following is the true connection.

The N. W. Corner of Willis Donahoe Survey is South 77 7/8 N. and East 175 8/10 N. from the N. E. Corner of Lefran Gedy Survey.

The N. W. Corner of F. S. Green Survey is North 319 N. and East 314 N. from the N. E. Corner of Lefran Gedy Survey.

The N. E. Corner of O. W. Hoover Survey is S 19° W 1187 N. and N 80° E. 2411 N. from the N. E. Corner of A. M. Lagarza Survey. From the plot sent you a few days since and above connection a correct map can be made of the surveys in the S. W. Corner of Hardin County (the connection called for in Napoleon Dewatts Survey can't be relied upon as the survey was not made upon the ground no lines or corners can be found of said survey.
