lines run for Geo. W. Turnbull to rectify
the Washington County R. R. Co. surveys in
Hardin County -

Beginning at the S E Corner
of a 320 acre survey of land Patented
to Hardin County and known as the Har-
din Town Survey Thence North 605 varas
a stake on East boundary line of said
Hardin Town Survey - Thence East 415
varas crossed the West boundary line of
Mary Mitchell's Pre-emption Survey of 1600
acres Continuing East at 420 varas come
to the S W Corner of Isaac, D. Knight Survey
of 640 acres a stake from which a pine
bears S 9° W $9\frac{7}{10}$ varas and a pine 24 inches
in diameter bears N 36° E 5 varas Continuing
East at 1365 varas crossed the East Boundary
line of Mary Mitchell Survey 120 varas South
of her N E Corner Continuing East at 2320
varas to the S E Corner of said Knight's
Survey a Magnolia bears S $73\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E $7\frac{6}{10}$ varas
and a magnolia 20 inches in diameter bears
S 58° W $7\frac{4}{10}$ varas - Thence South 1393 $\frac{5}{10}$
varas to a road at 2480 varas a small
branch 2650 varas a corner a stake from

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which a pine 26 inches in diameter bears South
82° E. 8 5/8 varas and a pine 20 inches in diam-
eter bears N 64° W 12 9/10 varas. - Thence East
259 varas a branch 2 varas wide runs N 52° E
Continuing East at 763 varas N W Corner of
Bentura Yonjosa survey a stake from
which a pine 16 inches in diameter bears N
26° 30' E 5 4/10 varas and a pine 20 inches in
diameter bears S 57° 30' E 8 7/10 varas

Corner a stake from which a Sassafras 11 inches
in diameter bears N 11 W 1/2 varas and a
White Oak 6 in diameter bears N 30 E 3 varas

Thence West 3087 varas cross the East

100 varas North of his S. E. Corner at 5000 varas
set a stake for the N W corner of the Francisco
Arriola Survey no evidence of the Bearings was
given in his field notes Thence South 100 var
to the South boundary line of said Yonjosa
Survey 1313 varas West from his S E corner at
1900 varas a branch 3 varas wide at 2000 var
Crossed Boggy Creek 8 varas wide at 5000 var
set a stake for the S W corner of the Francisco
Arriola and the N. E. Corner of Ignacia
