BEGINNING AT

the S.E. corner of the Champion Choate survey at an
iron pipe one inch in diameter, whence a forked pine oak,
east prong marked JNDX (very old), west prong respectfully cut down,
bank being the original bearing tree for the west course of the
B.B. & C. survey bears $S15^{\circ}E$ 54 Varas.

Thence south 465 Varas to the north line of the Willis Donoho
survey

Thence west with the north line of said Donoho survey 251
Varas to an oak stake 3" x 4" in the east line of the
F.H. Green survey

Thence N. $10^{\circ}E$ along the Green east line 567 Varas to the
undisputed N.E. corner of the F.H. Green survey marked
with a stake.

Thence S. $58^{\circ}23'E$ 180 Varas to the place of beginning.
