There is another metter I wish to call attention to although 1 fear the State will have no redress at this late date. There was a controversy between the owners of the Casanova League and the owners of the John TompB on account of a conflict so while there I run out the Tompson survey I ran north on the Thompson west line and found Menard Creek at 950 varas and a bend of same creek at 1.000 varas (both calls correct) but instead6 of finding his north west corner at 1.250 varas as called far, I found it at 1.725 varas, are standing. I then ran cast and found Menard Creek at 940 varas as called

for and at 3.182 varas a corner not discribed

Thence south on a plainly marked line at 1.865 Baras a corner not discr ibed, thence xeen west at 1.822 varas found east line of Carriere League

Thence north weth east line of said League 143 varas its north east corner Thence west with his north line at 1.860 varas the place of beginning. This gives the Tompson survey about 225 acres too much land, about 120 as acres should belong to the School fund and the balance is in conflict

with the Casivova League.

I dont suppose there is any way for the State to recover this land as the nort west corner of the Tompson is clearly discribed although it is 475 varas too far north.for its calls.

About one half of this excess is very heavy Pine timber, worth at least \$ 25.00 per acre for timber only.

Recently there was a controvercy between the Kirby Lumber Co. and the West Lumber Co. as to the ownership of certain timber being cut by the West Lumber Co., they claiming it to be on the Casanova League, the Kirby people that it was on the R. A. rion League. They sent for me, and in company with T. J. Hilley representing the Kirby Lumber Co and 0. C. Garvey of first Livingston representing the West Lumber Co. Together we made a careful survey of the Erion League and the vest line of the Casanova League. We first ran the north line of the Joseph Carriere League from the south west corner of the John Tompson survey , passing 1 its north west cornwe and intersected the east line of the Sublett Leagu we intersected this line 60 varas aprth of its south east corner, and found an excess of 90 varas. As the Sublett east line calls for 7.829 1% varas and the west line of the Irion League calls for 7.500 varasm, this s shows an apparent excess north and south of 270 varas. The old corner tree were down and a new corner made, we identified this corner by running norb and finding Henard Creeh at 140 varas and Rockey branch at 480 varas as called for in the Sublett field Notes. We then went to the south east corner of the Thomas League. this corner is still there and easily identic We ran east from thereand located the north east corner of the Sublett and north west corner of the Irion League, and continuing east located the nort east corner of the Irion and north west corner of the Casinova Leagues We found the old original lines of both Leagues bur no corners. Shese line had never been traced before as none of the trees had ever been re blased We ran south and located the Casanova south west cornerss varas west of h tax the Thompson west line and 1.517 varas north of the Carriere morth lin and at 7.500 varas located the south east corner of the Irion League 88 VE west of the Tompson west line and 267 varas north of the Carriere north This leaves a strip of public school Land 267 varas wide the width line. of the Irion League and a strip north 38 varas wide from the Carriere north line to the south line of the Casinova League or in all about 196 acres. There is no doubt that the vacancy is there. All parties interested are satisfied with the measurements and are willing to abide bi it.
