

I, J. J. Gillespie, hereby certify, that for about 10 years I was County Surveyor of Harris County, that I was present and aided W. A. Polk in running a connecting line from the S. E. corner of the Hendy Pierwester survey (which corner on the ground is established and well known to us) for the purpose of fixing the point on the ground where the Benton H. Freeling line would be according to its calls for course and distance, and also in meandering Simms Payon from the East line of James Hamilton No. 101 to H. B. Prentiss' West line, and I know that this surveying was accurately and correctly done.

The actual survey shows that the West line of the H. B. Prentiss, ^{prolonged} as established and claimed by the owners and recognized by surveyors, is $6008\frac{7}{10}$ or. East from the East line of the Hamilton survey # 101.
