Surveyed for James Scott one League of land, lying on Cedar Bayou, to which he is entitled by virtue of a Certificate No. 154, issued to him, by the Board of Land Commissioners, of the County of Harrisburg. Planted stake and made mound, on the South line of a League of land granted to Julian Males, for the Beginning corner. Thence with said line S.  $80^{\circ}30'N$ . 3590 ve, entered timber, 4560 ve, crossed Cedar Bayou, width 16 ft. Crs. South 5,060 ve, entered prairie,  $8\frac{333}{3}$  ve. Corner stake and mound in prairie, being S. W. corner of J. Males's league.

Thence S.  $9^{\circ}30' E$ . 3000 ve, stake and mound in prairie for S. W. corner.

Thence N.  $80^{\circ}30' E$ . 3560 ve, entered timber. 4,333 ve, re-crossed said Cedar Bayou 5,083 ve, entered Prairie 8,333 stake and mound in prairie 4<sup>th</sup> or S. E. corner

Thence N.  $9^{\circ}30' N$ . 3000 ve, to the place of beginning, containing 25 Labors, about one fourth timber, pine & oak, Eight Labors of arable, balance pasture land
