 To the Hon. Commissioners: The land surveyed for the Citizen Victor Blanco lay on the right bank of the San Jacinto River & from the lower corner on said bank, from a sitio granted to David Harris August 19, 1824 which corner is marked by a <sup>(curly pine in Eng)</sup> sabinia tree of 20" dia. From which to the South 3° W. is found another sabinia tree 18" dia & no dist. & another tree known in English by name of beech, a line was drawn to the west 10000. no to a stk. planted in pile of earth made per Cor., has passed at 2792  
 The D.W. cor said sitio of Harris see sketch <sup>heron</sup> with  
 Remaining calls as given in this p.n.  
 Signed Thos. A. Borders = Villa of San Felipe de Austin June 1st 1831. (Title indented 1828)
