James Rynerson

Vol. C - Page 8

Survey for James Rynerson of six hundred and forty acres of land; situated on the waters of the west fork of White Oak Bayou about ten miles southwest from the City of Houston; being the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of Certificate No. 432 issued by the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Brazoria;

BEGINNING at a stake and mound in the prairie on Shaws east boundary line.

THENCE North 1692 varas passing Shaws northeast corner and Hamblin's southeast corner of his labor at 598 vs. to a stake and mound in prairie Clarkson's southwest corner.

THENCE East 2135 varas with Clarkson's line to his southeast corner a stake and mound in the prairie.

THENCE South 1692 varas to a stake and mound passing Lewis's southwest corner at 760 varas.

THENCE West 2135 varas to the beginning.

Survey of six hundred and forty acres of land for Geo. Williams; situated on White Oak Bayou about twelve miles northwest of the City of Houston. Being the land to which he is entitled by virtue of Certificate No. 483 issued by the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Harrisburg.

BEGINNING at a stake and mound in the prairie Alexander's southwest corner of his twelfth of a League tract on Clarkson's west boundary line.

SOUTH 850 varas with Clarkson's line passing his corner at 750 varas to a stake and mound in prairie, Hamblin's northeast corner of his labor.

THENCE West 1099 varas (with said Labor line) to a stake and mound in prairie, Hamblin's northwest corner an Elm eighteen inches in diameter in a small island of timber bears southeast 10 varas.

THENCE South 1255 varas (with said Labor line passing his southwest corner at 910 varas) to a stake and mound in prairie.

THENCE West 1788 varas to a stake and mound in prairie.

Being the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of Certificate No. 29, issued by the Board of Land Commissioners on the 11th day of March, 1839, for the County of Harrisburg.

BEGINNING at A. Lawson's northeast corner, a stake and mound in the prairie.

THENCE East 1444 varas to a stake and mound in the prairie to James Clarkson's west boundary line.

THENCE South, 1251 $\frac{7}{10}$ varas to a stake and mound in the prairie Alexander's northeast corner.

BEGINNING at Kelleher's southwest corner. A stake in Clarkson's east boundary line.

THENCE West 1544 varas with said Kelleher's and Lawson's north lines to a stake on Lawson's north boundary line. Lawrence's southeast corner.

THENCE North 1234 varas with Lawrence's line to a stake and mound in the prairie.

Being the quantity of land to which he is entitled by virtue of Certificate No. 4 issued by the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Harrisburg and dated on the second day of March, 1839.

BEGINNING at a stake on Wallace's north boundary line being Stover's southwest corner.

THENCE North 1399 $\frac{1}{3}$ vs. with Stover's west boundary line to his northwest corner on Chambers south boundary line.

THENCE West 580 vs. with Chamber's south boundary line to his southwest corner a stake and mound in prairie.

THENCE North 1880 vs. with Chmaber's line to his northwest corner of Lewis south boundary line, crossing a branch at - vs.

THENCE West 640 vs. with Lewis line to his southwest corner on Rynerson's east boundary.

BEGINNING at a stake and mound in the prairie, Alexander's northeast corner of his twelfth of a league tract on D. Hanson's west boundary line.

THENCE North with said line 441 $\frac{2}{3}$ vs. to his southwest corner and McClellan's southwest corner a stake and mound in prairie and with McClellan's west boundary line 443 $\frac{2}{3}$ vs. to a stake and mound in prairie being Alexander's S.E. corner of his 320 acre tract.
