This Waiver of Interest is executed and delivered by Harris County for the benefit of the State of Texas and the General Land Office (State or GLO) in conjunction with the Armand Bayou Marsh Creation Project (the Marsh Project), a cooperative effort of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD) and the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT).

WHEREAS, the GLO has leased to the TPWD certain state-owned submerged lands in Harris County, Texas, as more particularly described in Coastal Lease No. 900007, for public recreation and for the management of an estuarine preserve; and

WHEREAS, Harris County owns littoral property adjacent to the state-owned submerged lands leased to TPWD; and

WHEREAS, TPWD and TxDOT have agreed to jointly fund a project to create 1.5 acres of marsh habitat within the Armand Bayou Coastal Preserve in an area adjacent to the lands of the County; and

WHEREAS, the activities necessary to complete the Marsh Project may result in the emergence or drying of submerged land adjacent to the littoral property of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County and the GLO wish to avoid any conflict or confusion which may arise as a result of a change in the character of the submerged lands adjacent to the littoral property of the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows, on the stated terms and conditions, in consideration of the mutual benefits.

1. GLO does hereby acknowledge its consent to the Marsh Project, as set forth in that certain 1995 Memorandum of Agreement, (the MOA) by and among GLO, TPWD, TxDOT, and the Galveston Bay Foundation (GBF) and the scope of work contained therein.

2. The County hereby acknowledges that the MOA requires that the present delineation between its littoral property and the state-owned submerged land upon which the Marsh Project is to be undertaken to be monumented and documented by the GBF.

3. The County agrees to, and does hereby, waive, relinquish, and release any claim or right to assert a claim to any right, title, interest, or ownership in state-owned submerged land, as documented above, which may become emergent fast land as a result of the activities necessary to complete the Marsh Project described above. Nothing herein constitutes a relinquishment by the County of any real property interest owned by the County.

4. The County represents that it is the owner of the littoral property adjacent to the site of the Marsh Project and has the requisite authority to enter into this agreement, binding itself, its successors and assigns and that the undersigned representative of the County has the authority to execute this agreement for and on behalf of the County.

5. This Waiver of Interest shall be recorded in the records of Harris County, Texas, and constitutes a covenant running with the littoral property of the County, binding on the County and the successors and assigns of the County.

## SUBJECT: Waiver of Interest in Created Uplands Adjacent to Armand Bayou Nature Center; C.A., File No. 60,657

At your request I have reviewed both the Memorandum of Agreement between the Galveston Bay Foundation (GBF) and Various State Agencies as well as the proposed Waiver of Interest that the GBF has requested of Harris County. The GBF marsh restoration project adjacent to Armand Bayou Nature Center has the potential of converting state owned submerged land to upland property over time. The state has requested that Harris County waive the right to claim any emerged dry land as a result of the restoration project.

As the project will not involve or convert any property currently owned by Harris County, the proposed restoration project and Waiver of Interest will not violate any existing grant guidelines in effect at Armand Bayou Nature Preserve.

Additionally, as the proposed project will ultimately benefit Harris County by reducing the potential of erosion in Armand Bayou Park, I recommend that the waiver be executed so the project may proceed.
