In the mean time please write me fully every thing necessary so that I can get it straight as I have had to do an immense amount of running to find these Capitol corners because they were not on the ground according to their connection. For instance, <sup>field notes of</sup> league 206 shows that its connection comes from Blk 49 N. & P. C. R.R Co, when in reality it comes from Blk L.C.<sup>2</sup> & no closing was made on Blk 49. After running every way that I could think of I finally found all of the corners called for in league 202, 203, & 204 & forward a certificate as to their position. Now the only thing that I haven't
