Dear Sir:

I have yours of the 12th instant in reference to construction of location of surveys in block 2, B. & B. Hartley County. I also have a letter from Dr. G. E. Ewbank of Dalhart, Texas, enclosing a letter to him from Mr. J. W. Piggan of Dalhart, concerning the same question.

In answer beg to advise that according to the records here it is shown that surveys in block 48, H. & T. C. Ry. Co. and block 2, B. & B. were made by the same surveyor, W. D. Olmstead, practically at the same time, in the month of November 1875, according to which these surveys, together with the adjoining blocks on the south, which were also made by the same surveyor, form one continuous system with common lines and corners. See blue print copy of the map by Mr. Olmstead filed in connection with these surveys.

In October 1888, W. S. Mabry filed corrected field notes for a number of sections in the northern part of block 48, which appears to have been based on the original N. W. corner of survey No. 35 and the S. E. corner of survey No. 39 in said block, as identified by him according to which there is a shortage of 27 varas to the section N-S between these original corners.

In as much as the N. W. corner of survey 35, block 48 is also the N. E. corner of survey No. 48 in block 2, B. & B. and the surveys in both blocks along the block line are shown originally to have common corners, same should not be separated or broken apart, that whatever excess or shortage that may be found in N. and S. distances between original corners in block 48 would likewise affect surveys in block 2, B. & B.

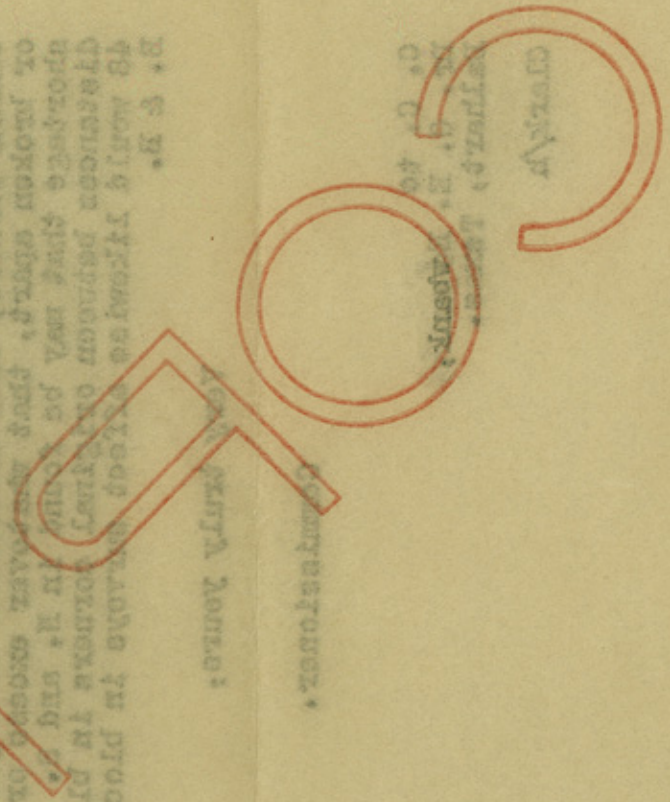
