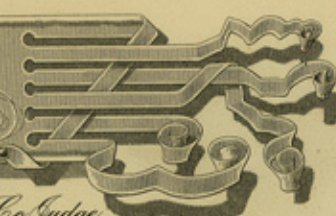

Dear Sir

I write you for information, relative to the Blalock file, I have resurveyed the Blalock, preceding the work on that survey. I located the South and West corners of the M. B. Raper - the South cr is 891 varas S 60° E from the East corner of the Heinnich Brashe, and the West cr 1010 varas N 60° W, shewing that the Brashe conflicts with the M. B. Raper, 334 vs and the York, about that amount with the M. B. Raper - the York and the H. Benson N° 137 have common corners, measuring the north line of the Benson carefully 1901 varas, we failed to reach the mound, claimed as the Benson N. corner, by 260 varas, this leaves a vacancy between the Jolley & Powell surveys of that width, the Jolley calls for the west line of the Benson, but both the N.E and S.E corners are fixed by witness trees, I am under the impression that the Powell cannot move out and that its S.E cr holds the N.E cr of the Powell, while the south corner might move out, am I right? I will submit the papers soon for your
