The square block on the Map is Isaac Gresson's Sitio. The dotted lines are the lines of later locations which conflict with it.

It is 4317 Varas East and 414 Varas North from the South west or Beginning corner of Isaac Gresson's Sitio to the North east corner of one third of a league of land surveyed in the name of J. S. Hallion and the above map gives the proper connection of all the adjoining surveys. The following Field Notes are a copy of the Original title

of Isaac Gresson's Sitio. To wit Commissioner. The land surveyed for the Citizen Isaac Gresson is situated on the east side of the Trinity River about 3 miles from the river and about 8 miles below the Junction of the Rivers where formed a mound of earth around a Stake for the first land mark from which a White Oak 25 in di. b. N 70 W 5 vrs dist. a Red Oak 10 in di. b. N 30 W 11 vrs off. Thence to the East ran 5000 Varas and formed the 2nd land mark from which a Red Oak 12 in di. b. N 84 E at 24 vrs dist. and a White Oak 10 in di. b. N 11 W 33 E dist. Thence to the North ran 5000 Varas and formed the 3rd land mark from which a White Oak 8 in di. b. to the S 40 W at 7 vrs dist. and a Black Jack 9 in di. to the South 10 vrs dist. Thence to the West ran 5000 Varas and formed the 4th land mark from which a White Oak 30 in di. b. N 23 E at 10 vrs dist. and a Black Oak 8 in di. b. S 42 E at 13 vrs dist. Thence to the South ran 5000 Varas to the first landmark.

I Samuel Shaffer deputy Surveyor for Henderson County Houston district do here by solemnly swear under my Official Oath that the above Survey and measurement on the 21st day of July A.D. 1853 I connected Isaac Gresson's land and believe the above plate designates the true location of it and its connection to other surveys of later date.
