The Survey of 559 Acres and the 81 Acres were made at the instance of Mr. Catron

Both Surveys of Isaac Williams are entirely surrounded by other surveys and take all the vacant land at each place

The above map is a correct representation of the Survey adjoining Isaac Williams, two surveys Joseph Levine Survey was made first and left only 81 Acres — The 559 Acres is bounded partly by Preemptions to wit J. Jansen and to which the certificate of A. Mc. Donald is applied and the preemption of J. B. Roberts then now surveyed for A. Layman Also I N Acosta and I N Sullivan on the North side are correctly represented
