Beginning on a post about 3 feet
 high marked P. 63 on the west side
 and P. 64 on the East side (running
 with variation $90^{\circ} 30'$ E) thence $N. 1^{\circ} 30'$
 E. 750 varas to the road.

Thence following the general course of
 the road with its meanders as follows
 to wit $N. 31^{\circ} E. 1000$ varas; $N. 28^{\circ} E. 600$
 varas (to "Misack" Ranch); $N. 38^{\circ} E. 900$ varas

Mosquite marked x bears N. 26° E. 57 rods
This post marks the division line
between the two parts of the said Balli
grant called the Cardinas tract
and the Melada tract and is, by the
field notes of said grant 15,000 rods
N. 80° 45' West from the S. E. corner
of the Juan Jose Balli grant.
