Sir,

Your letter of August 21<sup>st</sup> just to hand, in reply I have the honor to say that I have already sent you a protest against the issuance of Patents on Porciones 61, 62, 63, and 64 and 65, and I think some others, said protest was written while absent from my office and I have no copy. The Field Notes for said five porciones as well as those for Porciones 60, 70 and 71 were made by Mr. J. G. Evert and the calculations for the same also. The measurements were made by Mr. A. Salinas, Co. Surveyor Hidalgo County. I examined some of said calculations (as recorded) and found that they did not agree with mine, and to the best of my knowledge and belief they are all wrong, as your sketch shows.

I did not do the work and am not responsible for it. To correct it would entail upon me an expense and loss of time, which I am not willing to undergo without compensation. Besides it cannot be done for one or two months on account of the present great rise in the Rio Grande.

As to Porciones 58 N. Bocanegra and 59, Ramon Munguilla. I will say that I believe that the connecting line is correct. I made the calculations very carefully upon the basis of measurements made by myself and Mr. Salinas, and I have always found Mr. Salinas correct in his measure. He only runs Magnetic Courses, and Cardinal Points. In making said calculations, account was taken of the vacancy between P. 71 and 72. Therefore the said vacancy does not affect the true position of the Porciones above it, as regards the point of connection on the E. line of the M. Do. Minguez 1-664, and W. line of B. Seal survey, said point being called "Sindero de Amargosal.

To the best of my knowledge and belief said surveys of M. Dominguez and Porciones. #2 Jon M. Ballei are wrong. These two were surveyed a year or two ago by J. G. Evert, and that for M. Dominguez was patented, at that time said Evert was Deputy Surveyor of Hidalgo County. He was afterwards removed from office, but lately has been assisting Mr. Salinas without being deputized.

It is my opinion that the lines on those two surveys should run Magnetic or very nearly so to correspond to correspond with the rest of the Porciones, for in running the porciones magnetic old land marks were several times found. I also think that the M. Dominguez should be wider, which would throw P. #2 higher up the river and cause it to include all or nearly all of the vacancy existing between it and P. #1 as now Surveyed.

As to Porciones 66, 67, 68 and 69 I have to say that I wrote the Field notes and Record of them. Mr. Salinas made the measurements on the ground except the me-

anders of the river which were run by  
me and are correct. If any corrections have  
been made in any part of the record of these  
four Porciones, they are without my authority  
or consent and I protest against their use, I  
have not a copy of my Field notes here, but I  
believe that all my connecting lines except  
that of Porcion 59. are made from the begin-  
ning point of that Survey along the "Senderos"  
from Reynosa Vieja and therefore you have  
only to get the width of the several Porciones to  
know the lengths of the connecting lines, This  
being the case, all depend upon the connection  
of Porcion 59. with the "Sendero de Amargosal"  
on the E line of the M. Dominguez Survey ~~1800~~,  
and I repeat that my connecting line to wit,  
N.  $54^{\circ} 22' E$ . 21015 varas is correct and I can  
make no "explanation" of the discrepancies in  
Mr. Everts work other than that he has prob-  
ably made his calculations without regard  
to the vacuna between P. 71 and P. 72, which  
he knew was there.

An explanation is in order from him

as to why he ran the M. Dominguez survey  
and Porcín 72 as he did. Especially since  
I have been informed by old residents, that  
his lines forward surveys do not correspond  
with the lines run for the same tracts by  
Geo. Lyon, Dis. Surveyor more than twenty  
years ago and again by J.T. Fulton Dis.  
Surveyor about ten years ago.

I again ask for Patents on Parciones  
58, N. Boca Negra and 59. Ramon Munguia  
fa.
