Please find enclosed a sketch of the Jonathan Williams 640 acre & other surveys on the headwaters of Ash Creek I send it forth for the purpose of showing you that the Jonathan Williams 640 acre survey does not conflict with the J D Weaver 640 ~~acre~~ nor with the Jonathan Wallace 26 Lubore survey. You will find by inspecting the field notes of the J G Rutledge 320 the Beniah Graham 292 & the J D Weaver 640 acre surveys, that the S W line of said J D Weaver survey (if extended S 30° E.) is 3756 varas S 60° W from the North West Corner of O M Addisons 320 acre survey. You will also find by examining the field notes of Jonathan Wallace 26 Lubore survey, that the second <sup>said</sup> corner of said survey is in the N E line of Jonathan Williams 640 acre survey 3700 varas S 60° W from the aforesaid O M Addisons N. W. or West Corner leaving a vacancy of 244 varas between the N E line of said Jonathan Williams 640 ~~acre~~ & the S W line of J D Weavers 640 acre surveys. - please investigate this matter and see for your self.
