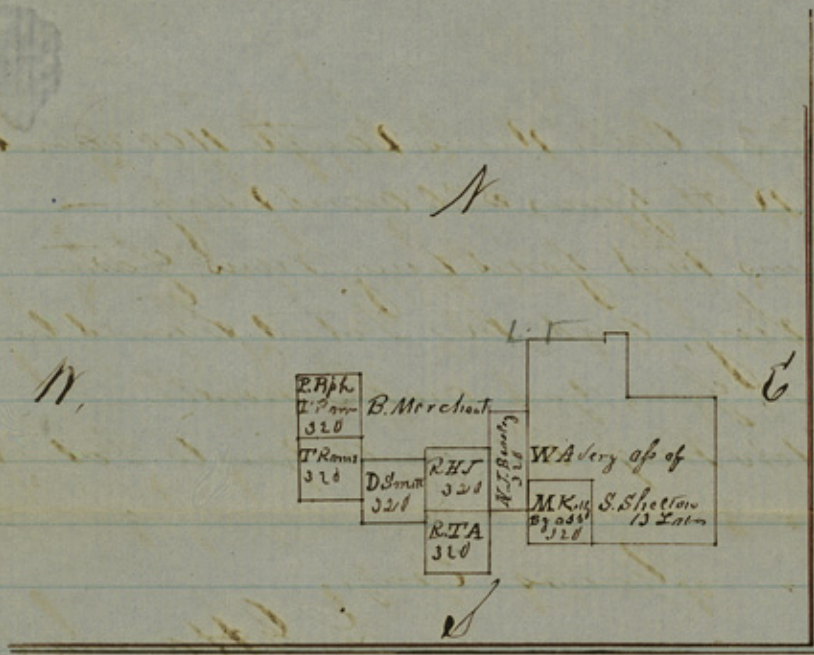

 the S. E. corner of a Survey of 320 acres in the name of
 W. H. Emberson, which is marked on the Plot R. H. J. —
 resurveyed for R. H. Jones, and Runs East 875 yards
 to the N. B. line of a Survey of 320 acres in the name
 of Brown, marked and this Sketch Map M. Kelly, by apt
 A. S. Gray, The Emberson Survey is resurvey for Jones, and
 the Brown Survey is resurveyed in the name of M. Kelly
 by apt A. S. Gray. I also send you the Patent issued to M. W.
 Matthews upon the Patent gives one Range Call which is
 the 2^d Call.

You will see that the 3^d Call Runs South 1100 yards
 to the N.W. corner of R. H. Jones 320 acres Survey —
 the Sketch map shows that Jones Survey runs farther
 North than Smiths Survey, and the Patent should be
 corrected, let me hear from you on this matter —
 I hope that the Sketch map will enable you to Patent
 the N. J. Beasley Survey.
