of Joseph, Richard's survey and covers John, D. Thomas, & H,
H. Johnson's League Survey

Permit me to say, that your statement
 in your communication to Mr. W. H. Linnell, that if the Thomas
Johnson Survey join the Black League, the calling of the field
 notes, would be erroneous is correct, but for the Johnson Thomas
or Richard's Survey to call for Prairie at the South
west corner, of the Staghinbaugh, League, the place your map
 places there would be equally erroneous in the portion of ground
 in case or west from prairie forest, the former Surveyor could
 have been mistaken as to what line he joined these surveys
 but he could not have been mistaken as to line forest to
Prairie, it was upon this conclusion that I have based

my investigations of these premises, which I made in 1864, and
 since that time have fully identified the corners & lines of
 the Staghinbaugh, Black, Thomas & Richard's, Survey and
 have divided these surveys in to from 3. 14. 14. 14. 14.
