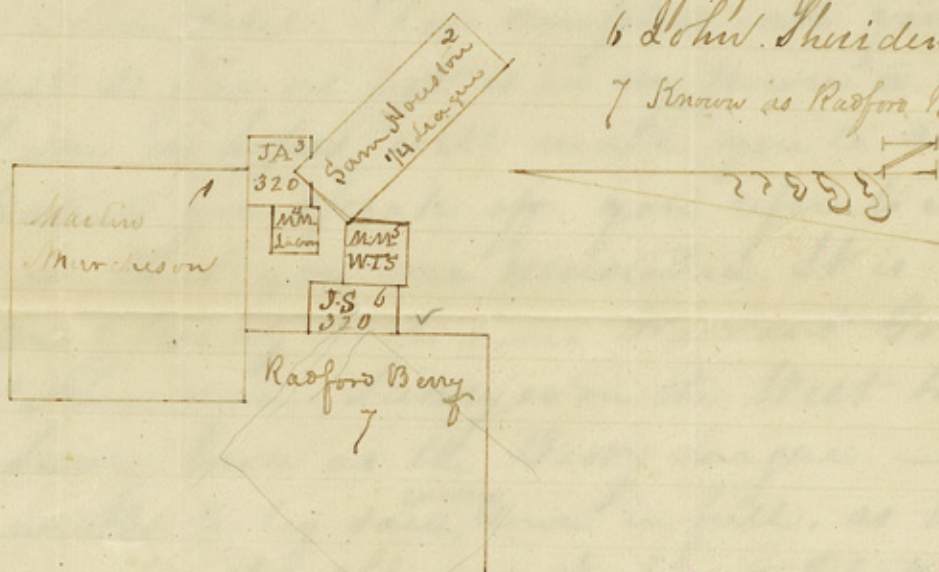

request so far as fit is in my power to do whi
ch I am in hopes will enable you to obtain
the patents you speak of. you refer to Sheridans
Labor in that you are mistaken, It is a three
Hundred & twenty acre Land Warrant Granted
to Sr. Sheridan, Surveyed on the West boundary
of the Survey known as the Berry League —
I am unable to lay said ^{survey} down in full, as there is
no record in this Office or the County Clerks dit.
Will you have the goodness to examine the Gen
Land Office for the title, I think you will be
able to satisfy the Commissioners as well yourself
that there is no confliction, I believe it is a
part of a Concession of the Government. Coheiler
