Dear Sir:--

In the matter of the Survey of the State lands in El Paso County for the Public School funds.

I have the honor to report progress of the work as follows, to-wit: That we have, since my last report, surveyed all the land lying South of Blocks 71, 72, 73 & 74, Tsp. 7, Texas and Pacific Ry. Survey, and West of Block 69, Tsp. 8 & 9 and West of Block 68, Tsp. 10. The survey of the large vacancy lying East and North of Sierra Blanca and South of State University Blocks G. N. & M. is well under way and will soon be completed.

Where we could do so, we have surveyed the land into Blocks five miles square and have erected large and substantial monuments either of rock or earth and rock, with four pits to each, at every corner and have taken bearings to mountain peaks or to some other prominent object, from each and every corner.

Our work has been greatly retarded by the scarcity of water, and bad route for wagon travel, which has caused delay and much vexation.

The S. P. Ry. Co. has kindly furnished me with most of the water th
