Pursuant to your letter and instructions of June 5, 1952 relative to the correct location of sections in PSL. Blk. 10, Hudspeth County, as surveyed by A.H. Parker in 1900.

I wish to report that during the month of December, 1943 I ran a survey line from the southwest corner of PSL Blk. 7, El Paso County to the northeast corner of PSL Blk. 9, Hudspeth County, both corners being in place and could be identified from the bearings given in the original field notes and from this survey I established a streight line prorating the length of sections between said block corners and established the southeast corner of Blk. 7., the southwest corner of Blk. 8 and the northwest corner of Blk. 9.

June 11, 1952 I surveyed a meander line from the north west corner of PSL Blk. to the southeast corner of PSL. Blk. 5,10 both corners were in place and could be identified by the bearings give in the original field notes and established a true relation between these two corners.

From this information I constructed a map showing the true relation of all exterior boundaries of PSL Blks 9 and 10 and have developed the relation and location of all sections within the limits of said Blk. 10.

I have also istablished the the location of the B.H. Davis (Old Padre Mine) Survey showing its location in PSL Blk. 10.

Jam. 18, 1943 I was taken to and shown the remains of the old Padre house by Wally Fields who had known of its location for many years. After finding the old house it was very easy to find the corners of this survey by following the field notes. Jan. 13, 1944 I made a report of my findings. This report is now on file in your office. This B.H. Bavis Survey is definately in Hudspeth County and is correctly shown upon the map accompaning this report.

The tax records of El Paso County show that no taxes

have been paid on this property since 1919.

I would like to know the proceedure to follow in getting this property and taxes transfered to Hudspeth County
