Enclosed you will please find a sketch showing the relative positions of certain surveys lying on the head waters of Sabine River. To wit R Roman 640 acres N<sup>o</sup> 110 & J. S. Cadle 640 N<sup>o</sup> 105 as well as C. W. Shultz Sea & Labor & others. It seems the patents have been withheld upon the surveys of Roman & Cadle on account of their supposed conflict with the Shultz Sea & Labor survey.

The enclosed sketch is a true copy of a map of surveys furnished by R. A. Leonard Chief Surveyor who assured me that the map was a correct representation of the surveys in that section of country.

We have other evidence that the Shultz survey is too far north as represented on the map. The South Boundary line of Hunt Co. runs 1823 varas south of the South Boundary line of John P. Bowen 1/3 Sea and John Bodine's survey and crosses at a point 138 varas South of the W.E. of the

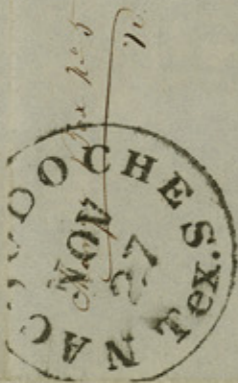
