Dear Sir
Having made said surveys on the divide
between the head of Middle Sulphur and
Willow oak Creek and for 650 Acres for Daniel
Dault and for 20 1/4 Acres for James M.
Hawagan Adm^r of John Woodard also a
tract of 820 Acres in the name of Thomas
Gaston besides two other preemption Right
Surveys, and after getting the proper Connection
of the surrounding original Surveys, I find
them differently situated on the ground
so that of the map of this County
either caused by incorrect mapping or by bad
surveying, should the original Connections
taken from different parcels, the field
notes of the surveys above mentioned
properly connect the surrounding surveys
of Middle Sulphur and Willow oak
Surpassing that the map in your office
to be like that of mine, I have thought
proper to make them on this sheet
of paper, as I find them situated on the
ground, so as to correct them on the map
when those field notes come to hand you will
find them connected as they are on this
Sketch map which Corrections I have properly
made by actual survey, I therefore hope
you will not refuse to pattern the same
on a Copy of the original map. Excuse
me for so writing and mapping for the present
