

Jacksboro Texas

I E. C. McLean Deputy Surveyor of Jack
Laud District do hereby certify that in mak-
ing certain surveys in Hutchinson County
for the Texas Central Rail Road Company
and other parties the following facts were discov-
ered & the following connections were made.

Of the surveys fronting on the Canadian River
made for the N. & T. C. R.R. Co. & the N. & T. N.
R.R. Co. the following bearings and points were found
& identified as described in the field notes of
said surveys. to wit: The bearing trees called for
in the N. lines of surveys Nos 10, 14, and 16, in Block
E. for the N. & T. N. R.R. Co. The bearing tree called
for in N. line of Sur. No 4. Block E. for N. & T. N. R.R. Co
and the bearings called for in the N. lines of surveys
Nos 10, 16, 28, 32, 36, and 46, in Block No 47 made
for the N. & T. C. R.R. Co. The bearings called for
in N. lines of surveys Nos 6, 20, and 38 in said
Block 47. could not be found. On the S. side of
the Canadian river, nothing could be found by
which to identify any surveys in Block No 46
made for the N. & T. C. R.R. Company

In running out the surveys fronting on the river
the meanders of the river were not found anywhere
to agree with the calls in the field notes and in
fixing said surveys I adapted the rule of giving
the N. lines of the surveys, or the first lines leaving
the river their length as called for in field notes,
unless the length was shown to be otherwise by
the bearings. All surveys were given the width

called for in field notes unless shown to be differ-
 ently by bearings. The Surveys on the South
 side were filed by making a connection with the
 S.W. Cor. of Sur. No 221, and N.W. of 222, in
 Block #1 made for N. T. C. R.R. Co. which was
 identified by its bearings trees and placing the S.E.
 Cor. of Sur. No 1 in Block #6 for N. T. C. R.R. Co.
 due South of same on S bank of river, and
 giving each Survey a width of 950 vrs and front-
 ing each Survey on river on South side, though
 said Surveys in no instance correspond, in shape
 with calls in field notes. The corners and
 bearings called for at N. N. corners of Surveys Nos
 222 & 223, in Block No 2, for D & G. N. R.R. Co.
 & those at the S.W. Cor. of Sur. No 220, in same
 Block, were found, and identified and the distance
 from the S.W. Cor. of Survey No 223, of said Block
 to the S.W. Cor. of Sur. No 220, was found to be
 only three miles, instead of four as shown by maps
 and field notes. The corners of the Surveys along
 the N. line of Blocks #4 & 5 for D & G. N. R.R. Co. were
 found and identified and were in a line due N. of
 the S.W. Cor. of Sur. 220. Block 2 as above described
 placing said Block one mile further North than
 shown by old maps. Blocks, Y, and Y. 2, attached
 to said Block No 5, for D & G. N. R.R. Co. were also
 found to be the same amount North of where shown
 by old maps. The Surveys in Blocks L B. 3. & B. 4.
 of 320 acres each, were found and identified
 on the ground. On N. side of river the Surveys
 in Blocks B⁴ & B. 2. were found and identified
 also surveys Nos 11. & 12 in Block N. and the

D. C. Cor. of Sur. N^o 11 in Block M. 17. and N. E. Cor.
of Sur. N^o 2. Block M. 18. The Surveys in Blocks
S. T. Block R. and Block M. 16. and the surveys
attached thereto were located by careful connections
made with well identified corners in Block
N^o 15 made for the St. L. & R. Company
they being the nearest controlling corners that
could be identified with absolute certainty. See
field notes of Surveys Nos 32, 43. and Block
45 for St. L. & R. Company in Crawford County
with which surveys connections were made.
Careful connecting lines were run between the
various surveys that were identified as herein
above named, and their respective and relative
locations are truly set forth in the certain sketch
filed in the General Land Office on the 26th
day of July 1882. Showing all surveys made
by me previous to that date in Hutchinson
County which sketch is hereby made a part
of this certificate. The distances called for in
the field notes returned by me are also referred
to as evidence of the exact locations of all surveys
found by me on the ground. All surveys
not found by identifying corners or bearings were
given the positions that course and distance
from points that could be identified would
give them, except the surveys fronting on
Canadian River
