Dear Sir:-

I will give you a report of the connecting lines surveyed by me in Hutchinson Co. in 1921-22 connecting the original position of section No. 16 block 47 H. & T.C.R.R.Co. by F.M. Maddox to some of the corners placed by George Spiller in same block and to corners placed by W.D. Twichell in block X O 2 ; also the relation of surveys in Blocks I. & Z. to said block 47.

I first began at a stone set by W. D. Twichell, set for the S. W. corner of section 1 block X O 2. Thence surveying East at 1142.1 varas pass 217.3 varas north of a large old pile of stone on the east slope of a rocky hill Spillers N. W. corner Sec. 25 block 47, from which an old Cotton-wood tree three feet in diameter marked bears North  $17^{\circ}$  E. 148 varas and another old pile of stone by Geo. Spiller for the N. E. corner of Sec. 26 bears South 119 varas, at 1901 varas passing a large pile of stone Twichell's S. E. corner of Sec. 1 block X O 2. Then placing the S. E. corner of Sec. 1 block I 92 varas south of the S. E. corner of Sec. 1 block X.O 2.

Thence surveying East from the S. E. corner of said Sec. 1, at 192.3 and 1183.7 varas pass 141.5 varas north of  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipes set by myself for the N. W. and N. E. corners of Sec. 24 block 47, in accordance with the Geo. Spiller field note position of said survey 24 as located from the Spiller position of Sec. 16 block 47 which is determined by the position of the Maddox rock monument on a high bluff on the north side of the Canadian River known as Dixon Point, at 4033.7 varas pass 2010.5 varas south of a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " iron pipe set by myself for the S. E. corner of Sec. 90 block Z and 110.5 varas south of the Maddox position of the N. E. corner of Sec. 21 block 47 as determined by the Maddox field notes of the intervening surveys back to the original position of sec. 16 block 47; at 6455.4 varas the Maddox rock monument on Dixon Point bears south 1947.5 varas. This rock monument is the original bearing corner called for by F.M. Maddox also by Geo. Spiller from a point in the west line of said survey 16 900 varas north of its S. W. corner; and from that point bears S.  $46\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W. 1900 varas. This mentioned course and distance is equal to 1378.3 varas west and 1308 varas south.

In the resurvey of Secs. 33-34-129- & 130 block Z I have placed the S. W. corner of Sec. 33 Z 950 varas west of the original N. W. cor. of Sec. 16 block 47 and the S. W. corner of Sec. 34 Z 1900 varas north from this S. W. corner of Sec. 33 or in other words the S. W. 33 Z is 4253 varas north and 428.3 varas east of the original bearing corner on (Dixon point) to the west line of said 16.

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Thence S. E. corner of Sec. 129 is placed at the original N. E. corner of Sec. 18, Maddox position which is 232 varas in conflict with Spillers north line of 18 and is 826 varas south of the S. W. corner of Sec. 33 block Z. The S. E. corner of Sec. 130 is placed 826 varas south of the S. W. corner of Sec. 34 Z. The S. E. corner of Survey in the name of Heirs of Alfred Benton being placed at the N. E. corner of Sec. 130 block Z. The S. E. corner of Sec. 89 was located at the Maddox N. E. corner of Sec. 21 block 47 and the S. E. corner of Sec. 90 Z 1900 varas north of same. The distance ~~between~~ between the Maddox and Spiller positions of their respective north ~~lines~~ lines of Sec. 21 block 47 is 261 varas.

I believe this covers and explains the relation of Block X O 2, I, Z, and block 47 one with the other.

Mr. Christian of Hutchinson Co. owns surveys 1 and 8 in the name of M.L. Anglin, and wishes corrected field notes on the two surveys. If you will give me instructions on this I will survey and prepare corrected field notes for same.
