Dear Sir.

Our mutual friend W. S. Wadley has shown me a sketch, furnished by you, of the surveys around Jacksboro, & also read to me a portion of your letter relative to the Arnold & Barrett survey, &c. All those surveys south of Jacksboro which call for running $N 10^{\circ} E$ & $S 80^{\circ} E$ &c were really run $N 11 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ & $S 78 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ &c, at least it requires this variation to trace the old lines on the ground. This I think will explain the relative position of the Patrick Osburn to the Arnold & Barrett survey when you plot the Osburn from the chain of connections coming round from Navarro Co. School land. The F. R. Balch field notes are incorrect. The S. W. corner of E. Bruton is 144 vs. North & 230 vs. East from the N. E. cor of Navarro Co. School land by actual measurement.

I have numerous sketch maps of the true position of
surveys in different parts of the County, but it would
be quite a task to furnish certified duplicates
of all of them, will however be pleased to
give you any data in my power relative
to any two surveys at any one time.
