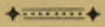

years ago - and I wish to know how you
will correct this error will you allow

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In regard to the Jno Shultz (vic D-161) have to say that the field notes & the patent call for the 5th line to be 950 rs long. It appears however that said call was formerly something else (probably 290 rs) but if so it was erased, & 950 rs, written instead. As the said sur is now patented to 950 rs it will have to go that distance, & to stop at 290 rs, as shown on your sketch of re-survey & subdivisions, would include a strip of land 660 rs wide that does not appear to belong to said survey.

Also it does not seem that the Shultz, Lot Thomas (D-159) Elisha Bruton (D-158), Lot Van Vechten (D-160) & No Isaacs (D-157) are in conflict with any other surveys, and hence

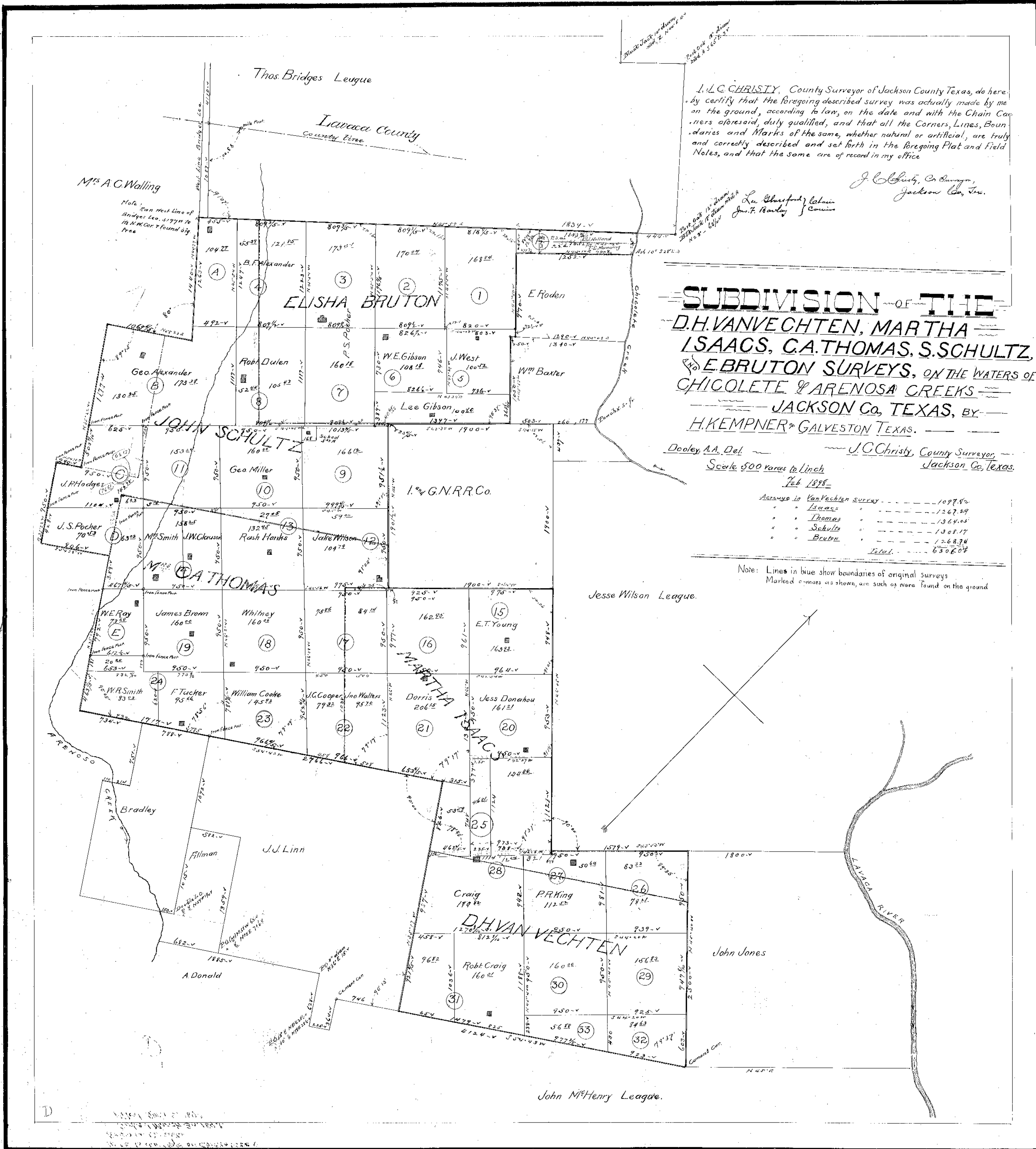
