

Jasper, Texas, Aug. 1<sup>st</sup> 1890.

Report of re-survey of lands situated in Jasper County, Tex. by L. D. Scarborough, State Surveyor under an act to provide for ascertaining the conflicts and errors in, and making proper corrections of, surveys of lands made for the Common School, University and Asylum funds &c. approved April 2<sup>nd</sup> 1887.

We began in the East bay line of the A. Nantz sur. 432 varas south of the N.E. Cor. Thence ran East on S. line of the W. Mitchell sur. at 1556 varas, struck the W. line of survey No. 83. H. & J. C. R.R. Co. Thence ran North on East line of the W. Mitchell sur. and W. line of Nos. 83, 87, and 76. H. & J. C. R.R. Co. and found the N.E. Cor. of said Mitchell sur. in the S. line of the S. Castille League sur. 365 varas west of its S.E. Corner.

We then began at the S.W. Cor. of said A. Nantz sur. which we found and identified on the ground and ran west at 1542 varas, struck the E. line of Mrs. Whitmire's sur. 80 varas south of its N.E. Corner.

We then began at a point in the S.E. bdy. of the N. Miller sur. 520 varas from its South Corner and ran East at 1211 varas made search for N.E. Corner of sur. No. 48. T. & N. O. at 1475 varas, made search for S.E. Corner of sur. No. 49. T. & N. O. found no line or corner marks, except those recently made by W. W. Blake County Surveyor for Jasper County. Continued East at 2210 varas, struck the E. line of sur. No. 88. H. & J. C. R.R. Co.

We then began at the N.W. Cor. of the Ben. Richardson League, on the E. Bank of the Neches river

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Thence East on his North line 9371 varas and re-established his N.E. Corner, old bearings entirely gone, but the E. line passes through a marsh as called for in his original field notes. We then ran East from his said N.E. Corner 475 varas. Thence North 1300 varas for N.W. Corner of sur No 56. T & N. O. found no line or Corner marks. Thence East at 1900 varas made search for N.E. Corner of No 56. T & N. O., found no marks. Continued East at 3800 varas, made search for N.E. Corner of No. 5. T & N. O. found no marks. Continued East at 4100 varas, struck west line of A. A. Joiner's sur. 125 varas north of his S.W. Corner.
