I, J. T. Robison, Commissioner of the General Office of the State of Texas, having been requested by letter from C. L. Gordon, County Judge of Jasper county, to designate the center of Jasper county, do hereby certify that I have, from the map of Jasper county surveys, and other data on file in this office, ascertained the geographical center of said county, and do hereby designate it to be a point within the limits of the Winton D. Pearce 320-acre survey, Patent No. 365, Volume No. 37, Abstract No. 407, about 180 varas N. 25° E. from the southern corner of said Pearce survey.

And I further certify that on December 30, 1909, a certificate was issued by this office to C. L. Gordon, County Judge of Jasper county, designating the center of Jasper county as being a point within the limits of the David Moyer 320-acre survey, Patent No. 850, Volume No. 3, Abstract No. 380; that an error was made in the calculations by which said point within the Moyer survey was ascertained; and that said certificate issued December 30, 1909, is erroneous, and it is hereby recalled and superseded by this certificate.
