Each of these two pine trees being long leaf pine trees. A concrete reference marker 6 inches by 6 inches in diameter is north 9 varas (25 feet), a 6 inch by 6 inch concrete reference marker is east 9 varas (25 feet).

Thence south 1 degrees and 32 minutes west, with the east line of the said J.I.Mixon survey, and the west line of the said

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section No.81, H.& T.C.R.R.Co.survey, and at 1300 varas reached the north fence line of the B.C.Coyle subdivision of 100 acres within said J.I.Mixon survey, a pine-knot in fence line for corner at a point 27 varas south 88 degrees and 15 minutes west from a 4 inch by 4 inch by 36 inch concrete marker for the southeast corner of a subdivision survey of one and one-half (1-1/2) acres of land owned by the Estate of J.I.Mixon, deceased, and situated within the said section No.81, H.& T.C.R.R.Co.survey.

Co.survey, a 4 inch by 4 inch concrete marker for corner from which a short leaf pine tree 18 inches in diameter marked X bears south 14 degrees and 48 minutes east 4-2/10 waras, a short leaf pine tree 21 inches in diameter marked X bears north 26 degrees and 26 minutes east 6-8/10 waras, a pine stump 20 inches

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in diameter bears south 20 degrees and 57 minutes east 12-2/10 varas, a pine stump 25 inches in diameter bears south 36 degrees and 03 minutes west 17-4/10 varas.

Thence north with the east line of the said Washington Mitchell survey and the west line of the said J.I.Mixon survey, and at 959 waras reached the south line of a forty (40) acre subdivision survey of land within the said J.I.Mixon survey and the Washington Mitchell survey, 12-1/2 acres of which is in the said J.I.Mixon survey and 27-1/2 acres of said 40 acres being within the Washington Mitchell survey of land, abstract No.390, in Jasper county, Texas, said 40 acres of land owned by P.N.Mixon of Buna, Texas, a pine-kont in said line between said J.I.Mixon survey and said Washington Mitchell survey for corner.
