league does not call for any Timber but with
some scattering Timber, now should this survey be moved 2300
farther North all the West line would be in the Timber
& about 2000 002 of the North line and this would have
made the S.W. corner in Timber, The Sophia Dean N.E. Cor-
I find in Pine Island Point 1303 002 S 90° W & 2100 N 81° W
from J. Gocums S.W. Corner It is an old Corner Stake gone
but the lines running through the Timber are plain

I think should be J Gocums S.W. Corner for it runs
for Manars East line which I believe is McKinnys
East line, all the Surveys East of these I believe the
Field Notes are correct, There is no record of the Vital
League nor of any of the Preemption Leagues
P.S. the line of RR from Beaumont to the S.W. Corner of A B
