Dear Sir

I received yours of the 25th June and according to instructions in relation to Survey No 7 for the Texas & New Orleans RR Co I have made another survey of the lot as follows. Beginning at a corner of the S.W. corner the same being at Favoring's S.E. corner at an old mound 14 was West of a natural mound in the prairie, from this corner I have chained (very carefully) due South 4752 was to a mound that I made when at work for the RR Co then East 766 was to another corner then South 4139 $\frac{1}{2}$ was and at this point I planted a flag staff. Then I commenced on the line running through Peretoto be in Jefferson County of which there is no field notes here on Record

Nothing known in this office about the cross league in Jefferson Co. A league in that name is represented on a sketch sent by Hardin Co. Surveyor, filed June 3/61, which however lies in Hardin Co. formerly Liberty. Of this league there is nothing of field notes on file in this office

that we could find. I do not believe that
the lines where ever run, (In 1827 & 8 Isaac
Burton was at Mr Hillebrandts & I was
well acquainted with him and some of the
surveying that he done sitting by the fire
at Hillebrandts house & I know that some
others of the old surveyors made more surveys
in a house than they did in the Prairie (Timber)
~~The other surveys I have not read
and have not been able to find with
possible to do this work correctly. I want~~
the field notes of a survey West of & adjoining
John Blairs League I have traced the lines
of this survey in the timber and I think it
connects with Blair if so I can establish
Blairs League & if I had the field notes
of B Eaves league it would be an advantage
in connecting some surveys. There is a great
many surveys represented by the Abstract to
point on the North fork of Bayou Din, this
being Pevetots North line at a stump on the
line 56 was East of the Bayou & run West 76
was to the prairie & continued this course
untill my flag staff bore North then chained
the distance and found it the same as before
I then commenced at the same stump in Pevetots
Woods & run East 2808 was no mound then
North a 3070 was Timber & a 2 back line running
through the timber (This line runs nearly all
the way in timber to Stivers N E corner) at 9300
was I find a Sweet Gum mkd with a blaze
& 2 hacks above & below on the N. W & South sides
as I would mark a corner, but there is no line
