1 Upon examining the Record of my County and the Field Book of B F Mott the Deft Surveyor of Jasper and Jefferson I find the Calls of Survey No 13 in Jefferson Co made for Fisher & Henderson are incorrect ~~which~~ in place of being situated South of a Survey made James Henderson should read South of John Champion and Beginning at the S & E Corner of Survey No 11 upon comparing the field notes of Survey Nos 11 & 13 it will be found that the bearing trees of the S. E. of No 11 and the N. E. corner of Survey No 13 are the same and the S W and S W corners also

Survey for Joseph Fisher and James Henderson of 640 acres of Land situated South of a Survey made for John Champion it being the quantity of Land to which he is entitled by Virtue of Land Serip No 343 Issued to Saml M Williams and by him transfered to Joseph Fisher & James Henderson Dated at New Orleans on the 10<sup>th</sup> day August AD 1836 (Signed Thomas Joby Seal)

Beginning at the S. E. Corner of Survey No 11 a Stake from which a pine marked X bears S 60° W 6 <sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas and a Chinquapin marked X bears S 58° E 5 varas - thence South at 1900.8 varas a Stake from which a Pin Oak marked X bears S 1° E 4.1 varas and a black Gum marked X bears N 4° E 6 <sup>9</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas - Thence West 1900.8 varas a Stake from which a pine marked X bears N 82° W 2 <sup>4</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas and a pine marked X bears N 49° E 3 varas - Thence North 1900.8 varas a Stake from which a Sweet Gum marked X bears N 1° E 2 <sup>4</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas and Pin Oak marked X bears S 42° W 3 <sup>8</sup>/<sub>10</sub> varas - Thence East at 1900.8 varas the place of Beginning Survey August 23<sup>rd</sup> AD 1839 by
