AUTHORITY FOR THE TAKING:

The authority for the taking is under and in accordance with the Act of Congress approved August 1, 1888 (25 Stat. 357), as amended, 40 U. S. C. 257; and under the further authority of the Act of Congress approved February 26, 1931, (46 Stat. 1421), 40 U. S. In exercising the authority delegated by this Order, the delegate shall be governed by the rules and regulations of the Department of Energy and the policies and procedures prescribed by the Secretary.

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All actions pursuant to any authority delegated prior to this Order or pursuant to any authority delegated by this Order prior to and in effect on the date of this Order are confirmed and ratified, and shall remain in full force and effect as if taken under this Order, unless or until amended or superseded.
